1	SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF THE MEDICARE HOSPITAL AC-
2	CELERATED PAYMENT PROGRAM.
3	Section $1815(e)(3)$ of the Social Security Act (42)
4	U.S.C. 1395g(e)(3)) is amended—
5	(1) by inserting "(A)" after "(3)";
6	(2) by inserting "subparagraph (B) and" after
7	"Subject to"; and
8	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
9	paragraph:
10	"(B) Beginning on the date that is 2 years
11	after the date of enactment of the Health Care Cy-
12	bersecurity Improvement Act of 2024, if the Sec-
13	retary determines that a cybersecurity incident led
14	to the disruptions of the operations of such hos-

18	shall not be made to such hospital under subpara-
19	graph (A) unless—
20	"(i) such hospital meets minimum cyberse-

23	"(ii) in the case of operations of such hos-
24	pital's intermediary, such intermediary meets
25	minimum cybersecurity standards, as deter-
26	mined by the Secretary.".

1SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF THE MEDICARE PART B AD-2VANCE PAYMENT PROGRAM.

3 Beginning on the date that is 2 years after the date 4 of enactment of this Act, in the event of a cybersecurity 5 incident, as determined by the Secretary of Health and Human Services, leading to the making of payments pur-6 7 suant to the program described in section 421.214 of title 8 42, Code of Federal Regulations (or any successor regula-9 tion), such payments shall not be made to a provider of 10 services or supplier unless—

(1) such provider of services or supplier meets
minimum cybersecurity standards, as determined by
the Secretary; and

14 (2) in the case of such provider's or supplier's
15 intermediary being the target of such incident, such
16 intermediary meets minimum cybersecurity stand17 ards, as determined by the Secretary.
