

2022 Congressionally Designated Spending Dollars For The Shenandoah Valley

- **Following Warner and Kaine's joint request, \$3,600,000** is headed to **Frederick County** to support the Frederick County Sanitation Authority's development of a well and treatment plant, which will provide an independent water source within the local community. This project will improve water reliability and increase overall system capacity to a part of the County currently supplied by a five-mile pipeline with no redundant pipes or backup water sources.
- **Following Kaine's request, \$620,000** is headed to **Harrisonburg** to help support James Madison University's teacher residency program, which is facilitated by the University's College of Education. Senator Kaine's [*PREP Act*](#) encourages school districts to create partnerships, including Grow Your Own programs, with local community colleges and universities to ensure their programs are educating future teachers in areas where there is a shortage of educators.
