



Workforce Transparency Act of 2026

AI is widely used across the United States and is currently primarily changing the nature of jobs rather than directly eliminating jobs. AI can improve productivity and create new kinds of jobs, but we need timely and useable data in order to understand those and other effects.

Senators Warner and Budd's *Workforce Transparency Act* would create a framework to allow for evidence-based policymaking based on secure, trusted, and protected data sharing. Establishing a Federal framework to produce, aggregate, and make publicly available data on AI can help create shared, universal datasets that the public and private sectors can use to better understand AI deployment.

The *Workforce Transparency Act* has been endorsed by Anthropic, the Alliance for Secure AI, the Business Software Alliance, Google, Microsoft, OpenAI, SCSP Action Program, SeedAI, and Stanford's Dr. Erik Brynjolfsson
